

Product Features Extension

Product Features are discrete areas of new and upgraded functionality that deliver value to your customers. There are features that describe what characteristics a product has.

When you explain features with a product, you help customers who have already decided to buy your product decide which product they are going to buy.

Product Features Extension by TheonlineHelper allows you to add the product features on the frontend product page. This extension gives amazing admin settings to add features for the product. You can add features in the description or in a separate product features tab with a single click.

Product Features Extension also gives you the power of customization. You can add featured images and change their sizes and text color from the admin settings. You can also select features for the individual product from product attributes.

Product Features Extension gives an option of permissions, Admin can set permissions for different store admins effectively.

Installation

How to Install?

- Download the .zip file of Product Features Extension.
- Extract the downloaded file.
- Paste the file in your app/code directory.
- Run the following commands to install the module.

```
php bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

```
php bin/magento setup:di:compile
```

```
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
```

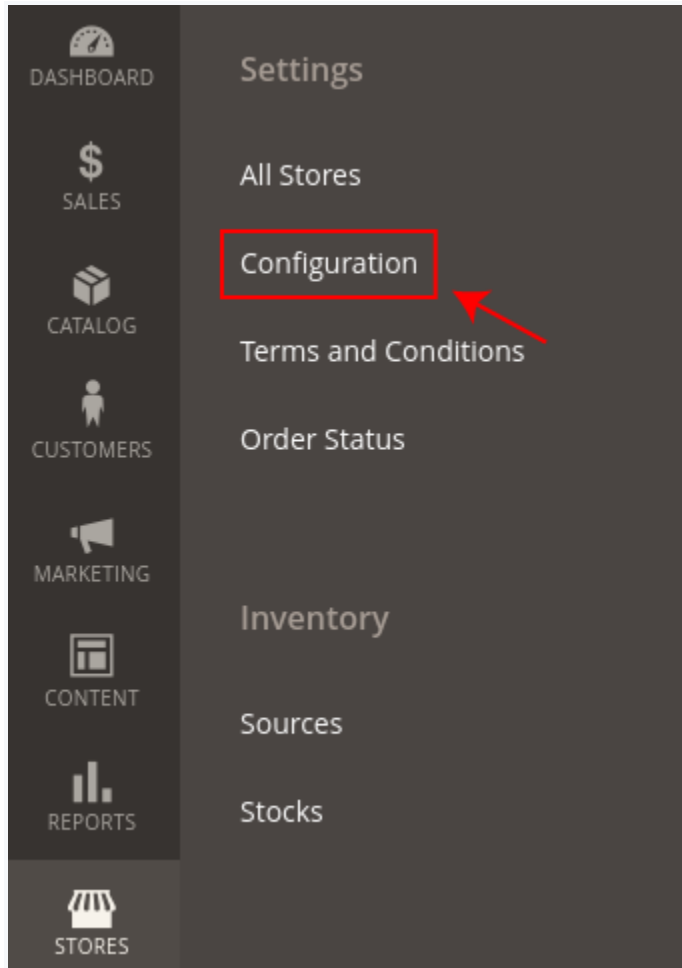
- Now run the command to clean cache.

```
php bin/magento cache:clean
```

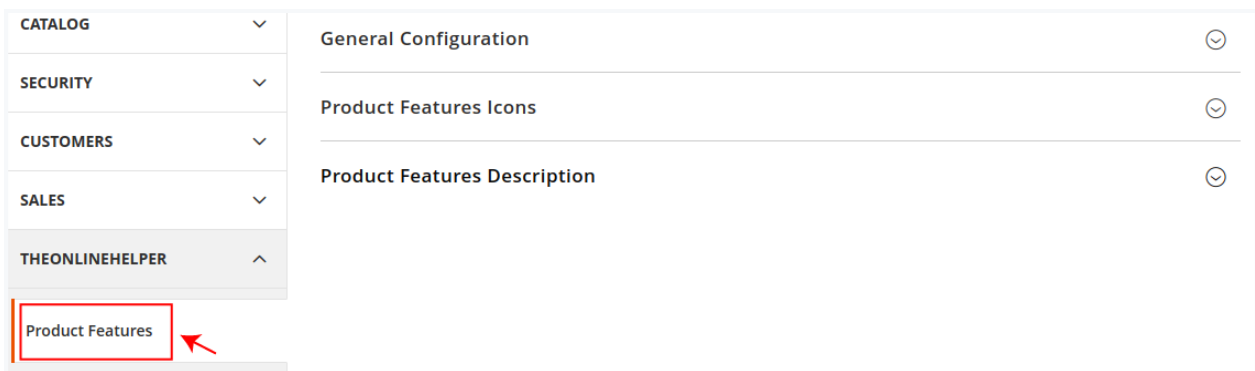
Configuration

How to configure?

- In the admin panel, go to STORES > Configuration.



- Click on the THEONLINEHELPER > Product Features.



- In the General Configuration, click on the Enable dropdown and select Yes to enable the module.
- Choose the desired option from the Display In Description dropdown, If you don't want to show product features in description select No. Select the Before Description/After Description option, if you want to show product features before/after description text.
- Select Yes/No from the Show On Product Tab dropdown, to show features in the separate Product Features Tab on the product page.
- In the section of Product Features Icons, you can change the size of the featured image.
- In the section of Product Features Description, you can change the text color.

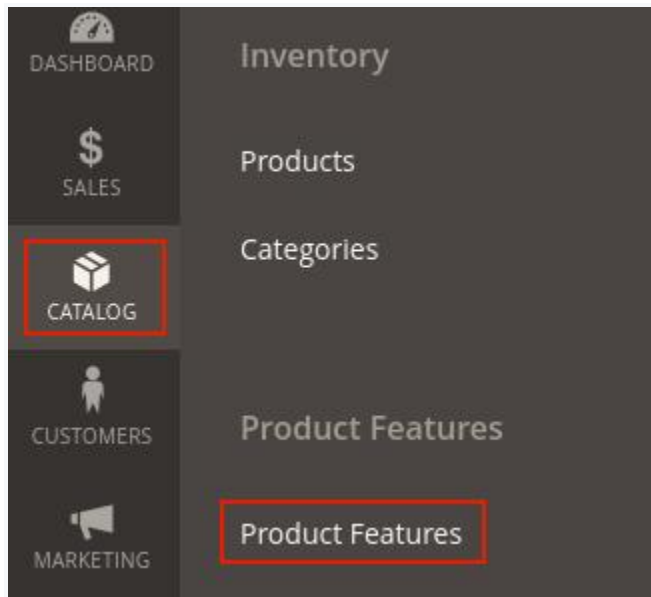

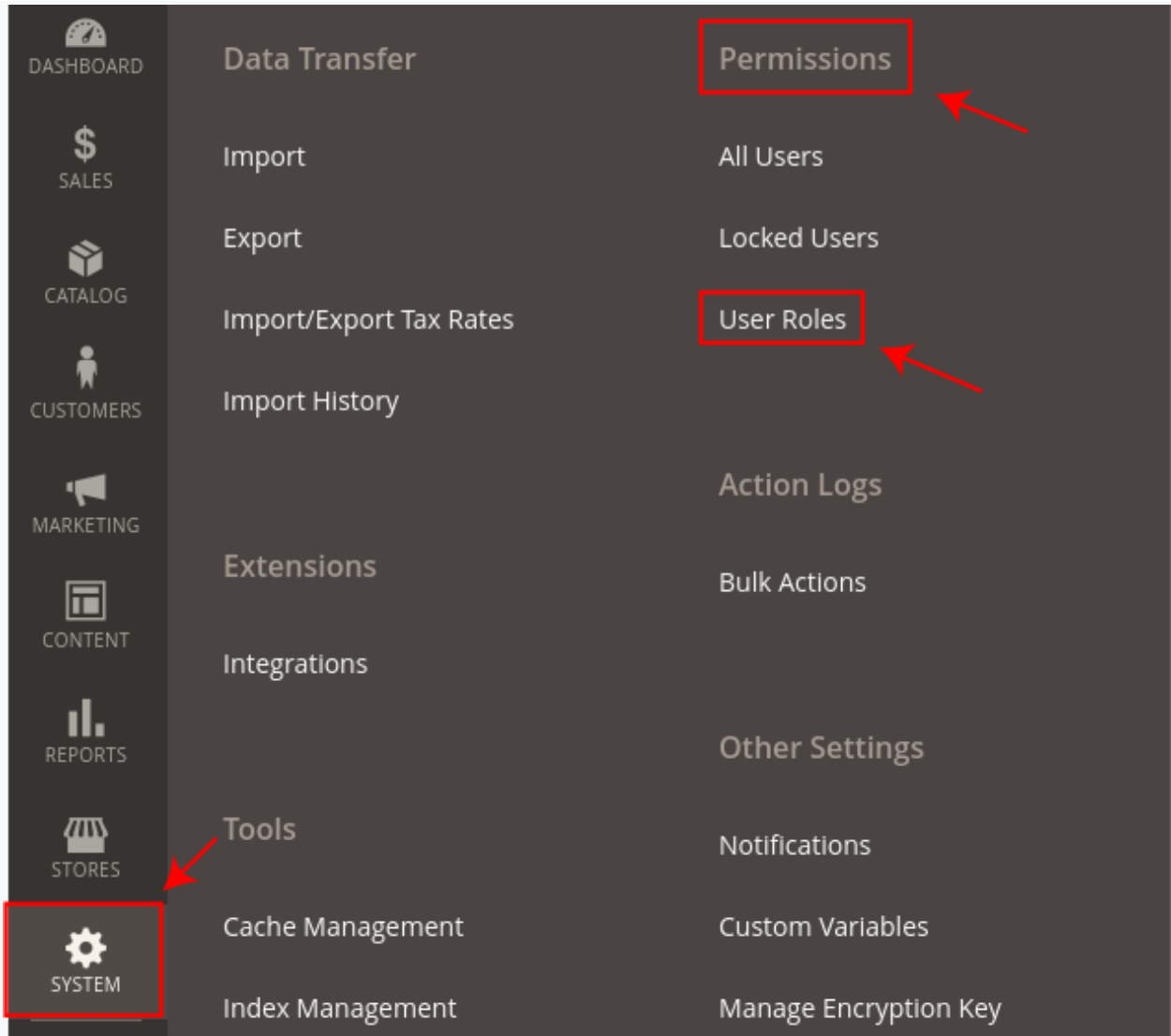

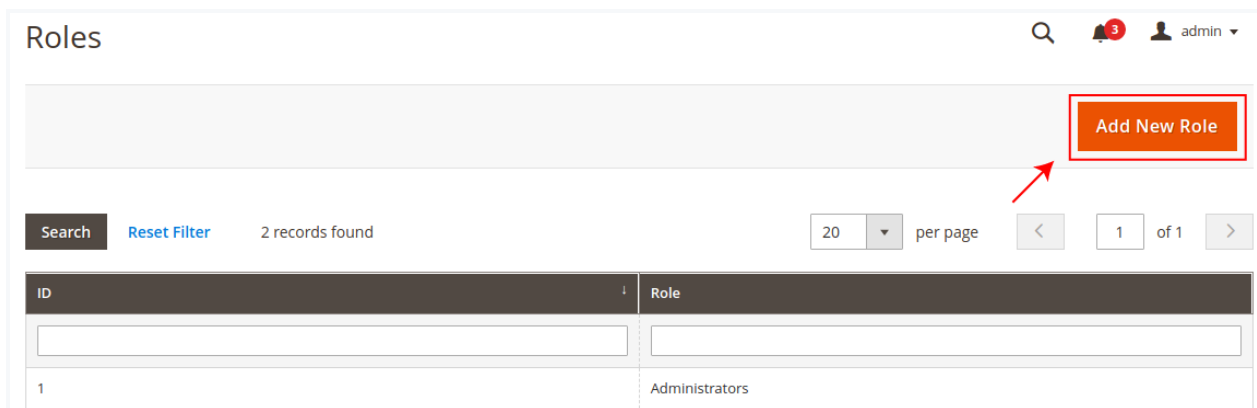
- After selecting, click on the Save button.
